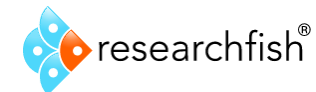

How to enable impact of SSH on a European level?

Recommendation: (1) co-creation of methods and spaces for trans-border communication and research design (2) don't be afraid of "marginal" topics or scholarly areas (e.g. minority languages) (3) voice for SSH in science policy (4) allow for diversity and plurality in the conduct of science in SSH and related areas (5) take social innovation seriously (6) be robust / communicate robustness (7) be aware of the (local, national, European, global) context (8) coordination of funding (watch out for funding mismatch between funding level and intended level of impact) (9) be confident in cooperation with other fields of research / avoid "victimhood" (10) mapping and data on available research findings and on research communities working around given topics – importance of harvesting data
