




- Closed bibliographic and scientometric databases
- Non-transparent indicators
- Even usage data of mayor platforms is being tracked

...or is it all a matter of individual taste?



- Leiden Manifesto states that journal indicators correlate poorly with research quality
- DORA asks to stop using these metrics in decisions on funding, hiring etc.
- Stop tracking science asks for data-sovereign infrastructure instead of spying on researchers' data use


Finally persistently identifying academic events and event series


