



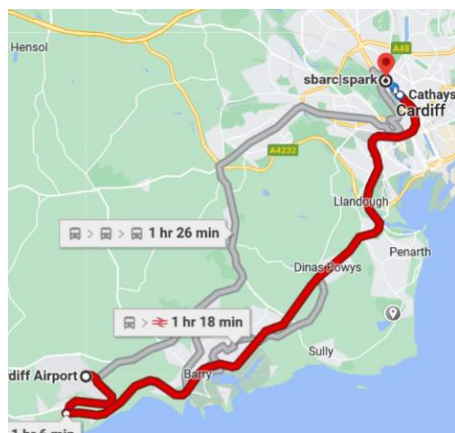

Locations and Directions

Conference Venue

The conference will be held in **spark|sbarc, at Maindy Road, Cardiff CF24 4HQ, United Kingdom**. Spark is Cardiff University's new Social Science Research Park, located at the heart of Cardiff Innovation Campus. It is a hub for cross-disciplinary knowledge exchange that provides state-of-the-art workspaces, recreational spaces, laboratories, exhibition spaces and rooftop terraces.

How to get to the conference venue from the **Cardiff Airport**:

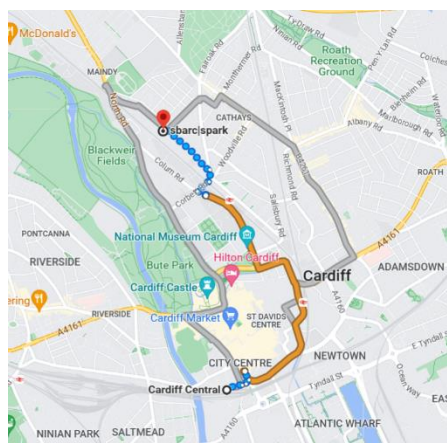


From Cardiff Airport you can take a two trains via Transport for Wales to get to **Cathays** station, which is a 10 minute walk to the spark building. Normally trains depart every hour. This journey takes approximately 1 hour and 18 minutes.

By public transport (commuter train) 1 hour 15 minutes)

- Take the train at Cardiff Airport (via Transport for Wales) towards Rhoose Cardiff International Airport)
- Transfer at Rhoose Cardiff International Airport and towards Mountain Ash
- Get off at Cathays and walk 10 min to the conference

How to get to the conference venue from **Cardiff Central**:



To get to the conference venue from Cardiff Central, you can take bus 35 or 9, and walk about 8 minutes from the bus stop.

By public transport (bus 35) (20 min, fastest route)

- Take bus 35 towards Mynachdy and get off at Park Place Stop.
- Walk 10 minutes to spark building

OR

- Take bus 9 towards University Hospital of Wales and get off at Monthermer Road
- Walk 8 minutes to spark building



Parking

SOP 30 – Car Parking

Pay as you go (PAYG) parking is available to all SPARK members & visitors. Clearly marked PAYG bays will be available from 07:00 - 00:00 (midnight) Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays) and must be pre-booked using the RingGo app: [RingGo mobile app or website](#) Search the location sbarc|spark to allocate your car park. The car park is code **39364**.

You will be charged when you book:

- Half day (4.5 hours from your selected booking time) - £3
- Full day (up to midnight) - £6



Blue Badge holders

Accessible parking spaces are provided across campus and at sbarc|spark for use by registered Blue Badge holders. Those with a Blue Badge are eligible to park in a designated accessible parking space or general parking space at sbarc|spark, free of charge, subject to a valid Blue Badge being clearly displayed in the vehicle windscreen.

Getting to Cardiff

Getting to sbarc|spark from Cardiff Airport

By Train

The train journey from Rhoose Cardiff International Airport to Cardiff Cathays station, with a duration of an hour. The train runs every hour with ticket prices starting from just €6.32 when you make an advance booking. Cardiff Cathays Station is a ten minute walk away from spark.

By Bus (local)

Cardiff Bus and Stagecoach routes run along North Road and Park Place, both just a 10 minute walk away. A direct Cardiff Bus route (95) runs along Maindy Road, with the nearest bus stops directly outside CUBRIC, next door to sbarc I spark. There are also several Cardiff Bus routes via Cathays Terrace.

Coach (National)

Megabus and National Express routes run along Park Place with the nearest bus stops outside the Centre for Student Life, just a 10 minute walk from sbarc | spark.

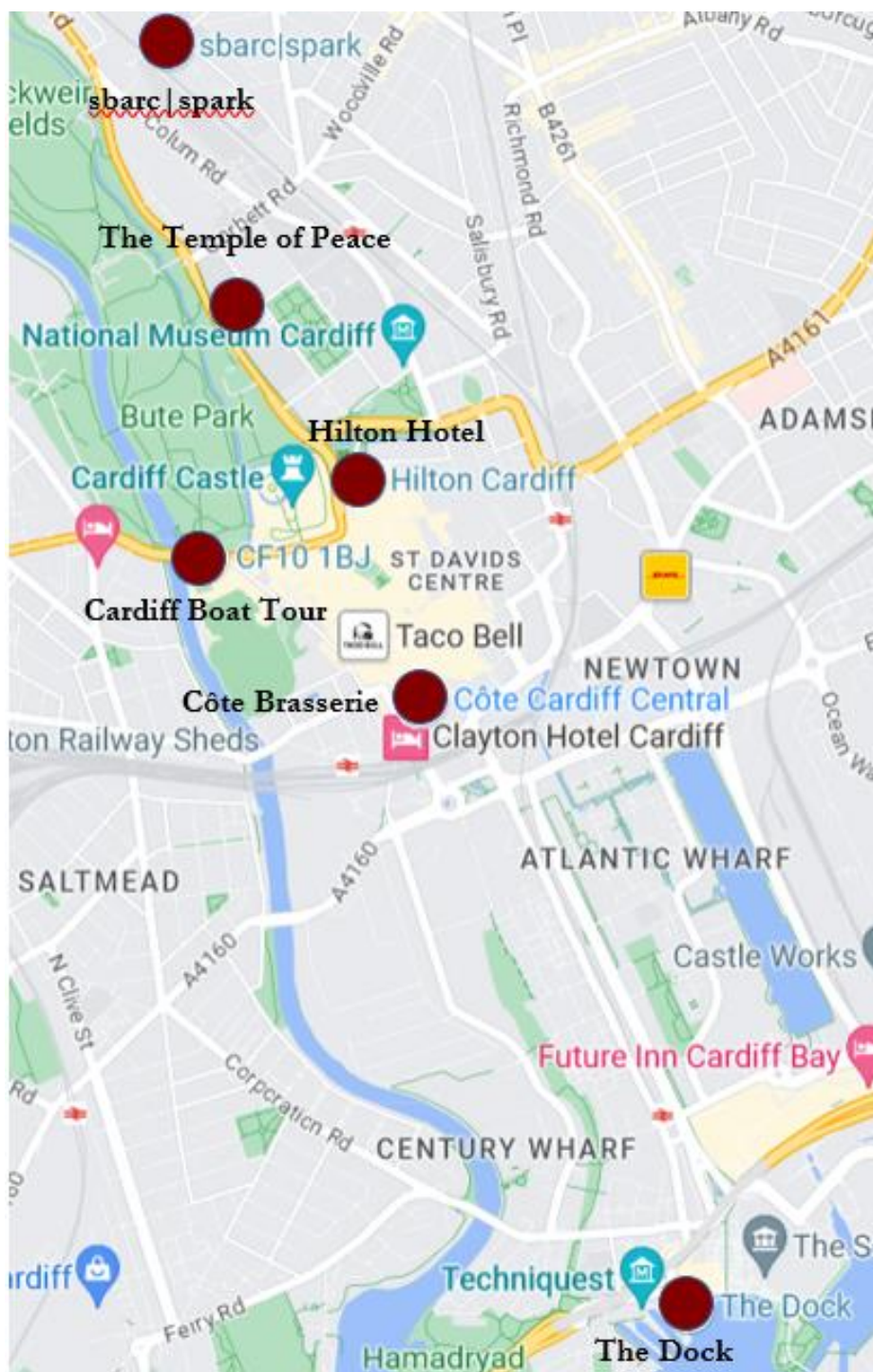
THE CÔTE BRASSERIE
