Knowledge Transfer Centers

Knowledge Transfer Centers: funding scheme by the Austrian Promotion Bank (2014-2018, 2019-2021)

Funding for three regional consortia of universities and universities of applied sciences

Aim: Support of all aspects of knowledge and technology transfer, including the social sciences, humanities, and the arts.

Total funding 2019-2021: 900.000 € per consortium

...what it is:

Consortium of 9 universities and 3 universities of applied sciences

Approx. 20 external partners (i.e. funding agencies, City of Vienna, media)

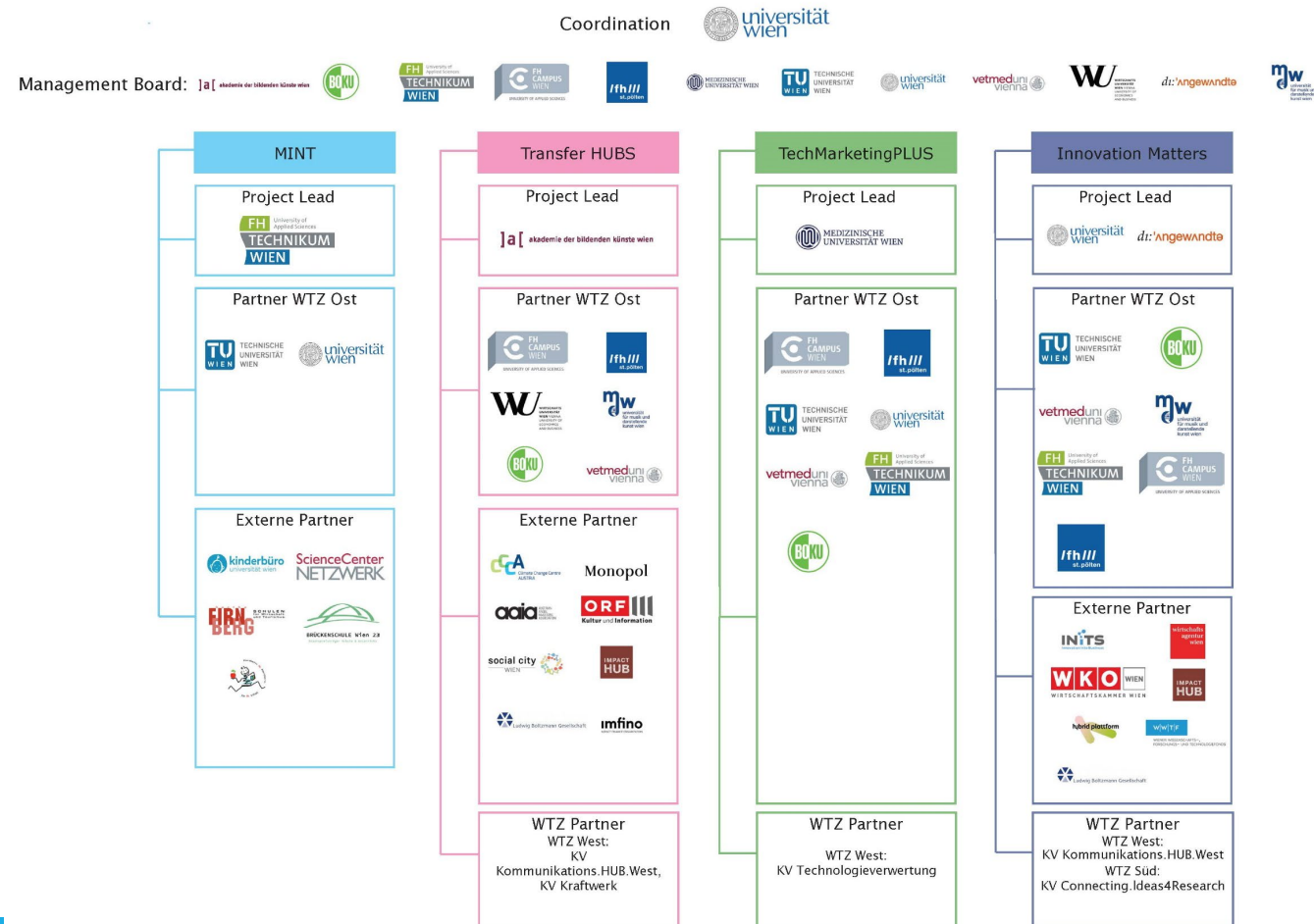
Structured in 4 cooperation projects

Innovation Matters: Networks

What we aim for: Establishment of inter- and transdisciplinary knowledge exchange networks

How we're trying to do it:

Conceptualization and organization of small-scale inter- and transdisciplinary networking events on specific topics; on invitation only.

Examples:

Research Salon #5 (Nov 2019, on site format): „**Health and Care**“ involving researchers from six universities from different disciplines (arts, technology, life sciences, SSH...) plus local stakeholder and practitioners (e.g.: Board of Trustees of Viennese Retirement Homes, City of Vienna, Caritas Care Unit)

Research Salon #8 (May 2021, virtual format):

„**Education. Perspectives, challenges, innovations**“ involving researchers from seven universities and universities of applied sciences from different disciplines (performing arts, applied arts, life sciences, technology) plus local stakeholder and practitioners (e.g.: ZOOM children museum, Austrian Institute for School and Sports Facility Construction, Chamber of Labour)



Innovation Matters: Methods

What we aim for: communication/teaching of open science and open innovation methods for scientists **and** practitioners

How we're trying to do it: following the Research Salon, organization of very topic-specific hands-on workshops

Innovation Matters: Transfer

What we aim for: following the establishment of networks and the methods workshops....to make transfer happen.

How we're trying to do it: development of transfer/knowledge exchange pilots

Aim: development of digital participatory prototypes for societal challenges
