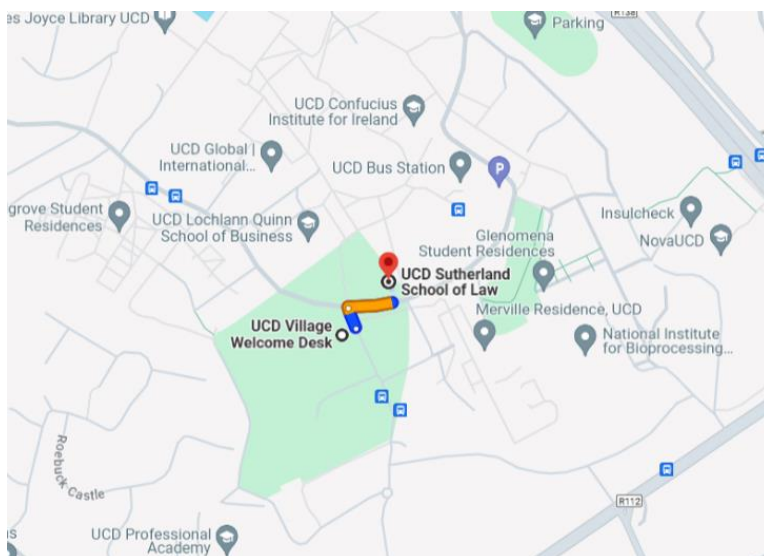
### Locations & Directions

#### Conference Venue – UCD

**Address:** University College Dublin, Belfield, Dublin 4, Ireland

This conference will be hosted in partnership with **University College Dublin**. The sessions will be held in the **Sutherland School of Law** and **Village Buildings**.

The Sutherland School of Law building, on which construction was completed in 2013, is the first purpose-built Irish law school in Ireland and was designed with the principles of community and communication in mind. The Village Centre is a central atrium space creating an animated dynamic environment to allow the University community to come together throughout the day.

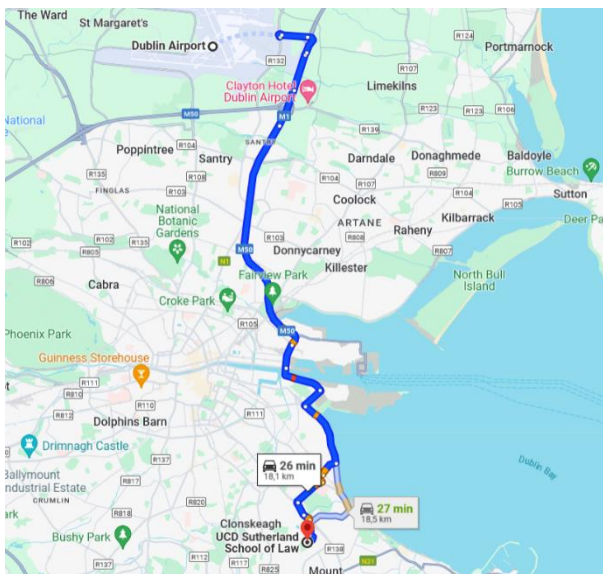


The Village Center functions as our main venue, where you can find the registration desk along with catering during the conference. Each day the plenary sessions will be held there, while some of the parallel sessions will be held in the Sutherland building.

The two buildings are within 2-5 min walking distance from each other, so can easily be moved between when transitioning to different sessions throughout the day.

## From Dublin Airport to the UCD Campus

By public transport (1hr – 1hr 15 mins)

There are a few routes you can take on public transport from the airport. There are a number of **Express buses** that can be taken to Dublin city centre *Aston Quay, O'Connell Bridge* stop, where the bus **39A** can then be taken from *D'Olier Street* to *UCD*. Depending on the chosen route the ride should take between 1 hour – 1 hour 15 minutes.

By taxi (25 – 30 min)

You can get a taxi from outside the airport or use the app '[freenow](#)' to drive you to your destination. If there are no complications, the ride to UCD should take between 20 - 25 minutes depending on traffic.

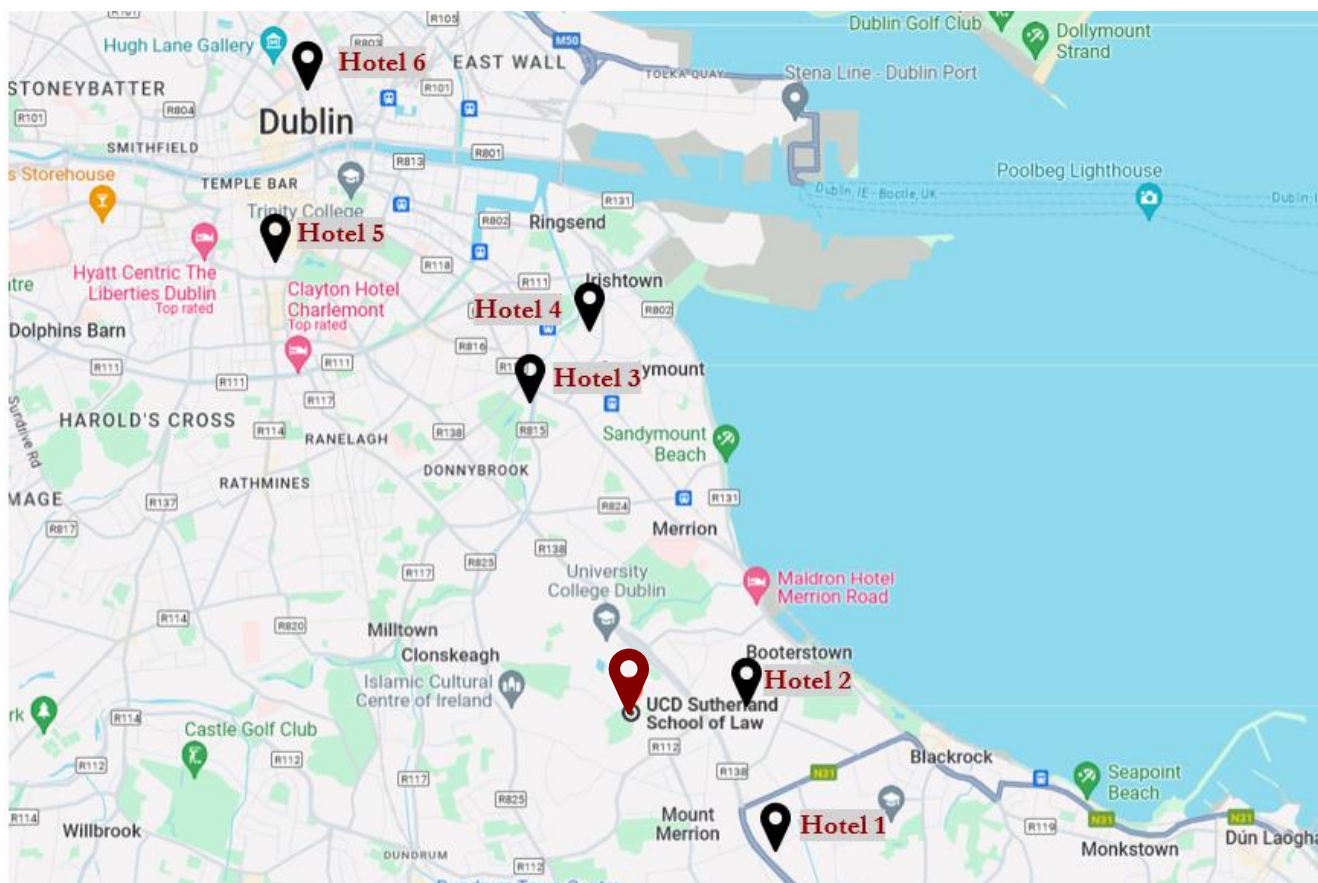

**Chester Beatty Library Museum Tour** | Chester Beatty, Dublin Castle, Dublin 2, Ireland

This popular Dublin museum named for the second generation Irish American collector is home to a number of collections from all over the world, including Europe, the Middle East, and Asia. Exhibitions such as those on 'Arts of the Book' (1<sup>st</sup> floor gallery) and 'Sacred Traditions' (2<sup>nd</sup> floor gallery) explore traditions and developments across East Asian, Islamic and Western worlds.

- A coach will be available to take to the museum, departing from UCD at 15.45.
- There will be a 20 minute introduction in the museum's auditorium after which you will have about 1 hr to explore the exhibitions on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors independently (2 guides will be present on these floors if you have any questions).
- We will leave at 17.30 from the museum and have a walking tour on the way to the conference dinner.
