Conference Venue

UCT Graduate School of Business Conference Centre

The conference will be hosted in partnership with the **University of Cape Town.** The UCT GSB's Conference Centre, opened in 2019, operates in conjunction with the Protea Hotel by Marriott® Breakwater Lodge.






Situated at the V&A Waterfront, the UCT GSB Conference Centre boasts a prime location in one of Cape Town's most iconic and bustling areas.

The conference centre is situated on the eastern side of the UCT Graduate School of Business and to the north of the Heritage Wall.

From Cape Town International Airport to the UCT GSB's Conference Centre



By Ride-Hailing Service (Uber/Bolt) (20 – 30 min; ZAR200-300 (€10-15))

Ride-hailing services like Uber or Bolt provide a convenient and cost-effective way to reach the conference centre. The journey takes about 20-30 minutes, with a fare of approximately ZAR200-300 (€10-15). The price is calculated upfront, and these services tend to be cheaper than traditional taxis.

By Shuttle Service (20 – 30 min; ZAR350-500 (€18-25))

You can pre-book and schedule a private transfer from the airport to the UCT USB's Conference Centre. The ride takes around 20-30 minutes and costs circa ZAR350-500 (€18-25), depending on the provider and vehicle chosen. Convenient options that provide their prices in advance are 'Airport Shuttle Cape Town' or 'V Transfers'.

By Taxi (20 – 30 min; ZAR300-400 (€15-20))

Metered taxis are available at the airport's official taxi rank. The trip to the UCT GSB Conference Centre takes around 20-30 minutes and costs approximately ZAR300-400 (€15-20), depending on traffic.

Please note that there is **no public transport** available from and to Cape Town International Airport. The former MyCiTi-service connection has been suspended as of 1st December 2022.



Activity Recommendations

Table Mountain

Explore the most scenic landmark of Cape Town and gain a breathtaking view over the city. Either choose a hiking trail that fits within your available time, or take the Table Mountain Aerial Cableway. You can find more information on the different hiking trails here. The specifications listed below apply to the cableway option:

Location: 5821 Tafelberg Rd, Table Mountain (Nature Reserve), Cape Town, 8001

Duration: The cable car ride to the top takes about **5 minutes**. You should plan in sufficient time at the top to explore the summit and enjoy the views. Possible queue times at the cableway can extent the required time. In total the trip takes around **1-2 hours.**

Cost: ZAR430 (€22) *Tipp: pre-booking online & for after 13:00 offers lower rates*

Robben Island

The UNESCO world heritage site provides unique insights into South Africa's rich history. For centuries, Robben Island was used as a place of exile and imprisonment, most notably during the apartheid era, when it housed political prisoners like Nelson Mandela. Guided tours of the museum including a short ferry ride from the V&A Waterfront provide an educational experience, enriching any visit to Cape Town.

Location: the ferry departs from 'The Nelson Mandela Gateway' V&A Waterfront, Cape Town, 8001

Duration: around **4 hours** (incl. two ferry trips of 30-60 min)

Cost: South Africans ZAR400 (€20,50); non South Africans ZAR600 (€30,50)

Booking: via the Robben Island Museum website

Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden

Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden, nestled at the foot of Table Mountain in Cape Town, is one of the world's most renowned botanical gardens. Showcasing a rich diversity of South Africa's unique flora, the garden offers breathtaking landscapes, tranquil walking paths, and the iconic Boomslang Canopy Walkway.

Tipp: Free guided tours of the garden take place from Mondays to Fridays at 10:00, 11:00 and 14:00.

Location: Rhodes Dr, Newlands, Cape Town, 7735

Duration: From Cape Town city centre it is a 10-15 min drive to Kirstenbosch. A visit typically takes about **2-3 hours**. The guided tours take approximately 90 minutes.

Cost: SADC residents ZAR100 (€5); African non-SADC residents ZAR140 (€7); non-African ZAR230 (€12)

Boulders Beach

Boulders Beach is a scenic coastal destination renowned for its crystal-clear waters and distinctive granite boulders. The beach is home to a vibrant colony of African penguins, making it a unique spot where visitors can enjoy stunning landscapes and observe these fascinating creatures in their natural habitat.

Location: Simon's Town, Cape Town, 7995

Duration: Boulders Beach is located a 50 min drive outside Cape Town. When planning to spend 1-2 hours on the beach, the entire trip should be estimated to take at least around **3 hours**.

Cost: South African residents ZAR45 (€2); SADC nationals ZAR95 (€5); non-South African ZAR190 (€10)

Booking: pre-booking is not required, the entrance fee can be paid at the gate
